Our Program

ARC utilizes a modified therapeutic community (TC) model to assist clients with making positive changes. A TC offers a highly structured environment where members can help themselves and each other make better choices that support sobriety. ARC also implements Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and behavioral modification techniques to improve client insight on their thoughts and behaviors and how these impact their addiction.
